Proposition 202 Funds % of Net Win

- 12% of Tribal Contributions go directly to cities, towns and counties
- 88% of Tribal Contributions to AZ Benefits Funds
 - 56% Instructional Improvement
 - 28% Trauma and Emergency Services
 - 8% Wildlife Conservation Fund
 - 8% Tourism Fund

- Benefit the general public including:
 - Public Safety
 - Mitigation of impacts of Gaming
 - Promotion of Commerce
 - Economic Development Activities
